
- Professor Boitier stimulated my interest in a topic that I had previously not enjoyed in highschool. He was very engaging and related material to applicable current events.




- I loved how organized this course was in terms of the practice midterms, quizzes, and overall transparency from a scheduling perspective.

- I really liked the structure of the class and how I could go into class everyday and know what to expect.





